



Upload toilet facilities and BINS4Blokes to the National Public Toilet Map (NPTM) and give men and boys with incontinence the confidence to get out and about

Follow these steps to update the National Public Toilet Map

1. LOG IN to the NPTM website on your browser toiletmap.gov.au

- Choose **LOG IN** just above the map if you have an existing account OR
- **REGISTER** and create a new account
- **CONFIRM** your new account via your email

2. To ADD a new toilet to the map

- Choose **ADD A TOILET** from the TAB located just above the map
- Enter the **NAME** of the facility (e.g. Library Restroom)
- Select **TYPE** of toilet from the drop-down **MENU** options
- Add the toilet **ADDRESS** and useful **NOTES** (landmarks, opening hours)
- When you reach **AMENITIES** select the BINS4Blokes symbol
- Make sure to **SAVE**

3. To UPDATE an existing toilet facility on the map

- Choose **FIND** from the **MENU** and search for the toilet on the map

- Choose **MORE INFORMATION**
- Choose **UPDATE THIS FACILITY** at the bottom of the window
- Find the information that you want to update, choose **UPDATE**
- Make sure to **SAVE**

4. To ADD BINS4Blokes as a toilet facility feature

- When in the **UPDATE** window scroll to **AMENITIES** and choose **UPDATE**
- Choose male toilets and select the BINS4Blokes symbol 
- Make sure to **SAVE**
